Requirements:

Artists must be 18 years of age or younger on May 1, 2021.

- Fill out and include submission form
- Maximum 5 original art pieces by the submitting artist
 - JPG format preferred.
 - Please provide a caption. Captions should fit the following format:
 "Title" by Artist's first name (materials used/medium) [year created]
- An artist bio. Not to exceed 50 words.
- An artist statement describing your inspiration, your methods, your message, or your hopes for your future career. Not to exceed 150 words.
- A schedule of 7 posts (Monday through Sunday) for Facebook and Instagram.
 - Posts may include but are not limited to: additional images of the artists work, a virtual artist talk, a high-speed shot of a work in progress
 - You're encouraged to include applicable hashtags!
 - Be creative, innovative, and (most importantly) yourself!

Applications must be received on or before 5:00pm on Friday, April 2, 2021.

- No profanities are allowed in content of exhibit, artwork, or social media posts
